Residency Description: Dacia Gallery is pleased to announce its Artist Residency Program in New York City. The painting intensive program will comprise of drawing and painting the figure from life, guest lecturers, a business of art course and gallery visits. Additionally, Dacia Gallery will host a group exhibition of your artwork created during the program. The Art Studio is located in the heart of New York City among all the major galleries in the city, providing maximum exposure to today's contemporary art scene. Art walks will be taken during opening receptions to explore today's contemporary art scene. Your time is meant to be productive, illuminating and memorable.

Invitation to Artists: The Artist Residency is open to all visual artists and will accommodate all levels of experience, from the beginner, who is seeking to develop basic skills, to the advanced artist, who may be interested in insights into the instructor's approach and practices. Artists living in New York, national and international artists are invited to attend.

What to Expect: Artists will meet daily at our Artist Studio under teacher instruction. Art classes will alternate between figure painting, the business of art, guest speakers and gallery visits. You will meet professionals in the art world and develop your network, make new artist friends and have fun in and outside of the studio.

Art Exhibition: It's your moment in the spotlight. On the last Saturday night of the program from 5-8pm Dacia Gallery will host a formal Opening Reception & Exhibition presenting your work in a group show that is open to the public. Lee Vasu, the founder and curator of Dacia Gallery, will be on hand to help each artist prepare for the show. Once the public has arrived, each participating artist will give an artist talk to the assembled crowd outlining the featured artwork and methodology to collectors, artists, gallerists and the admiring public.

COURSES & ITINERARY

Figure Painting Intensive: Monday - Thursday, 10am - 4pm: Class will focus on painting from the live model. Pose lengths will vary from short to long, and each student will produce a body of work, focusing under instructor guidance on different aspects of the figure, such as form, light, shape, distribution of force, mood, and personality. The aspects discussed will aid the student to develop three fundamental elements of figurative drawing and painting: the technique of drawing, the skill of seeing the figure, and the introduction of life into a painting. The class will also include short lectures, instructor demonstrations, extended painting sessions, and personalized critique of the work produced, with suggestions for future practice. The instructor is present during all classes, assisting each artist during this intensive figure-painting course.

The Business of Art: Monday evening we feature a lecture course on the business of art. Clarifying to artists the inner workings of the art world and how to successfully market one's artistic career to achieve representation by a gallery or an arts institution. We will discuss how to advertise and market your work, how to establish prices and how to approach a gallery for a solo or group exhibition. Professionalism and presentation is of utmost importance and we want to prepare you for all the ups and downs of what it takes to successfully exhibit your artwork. While we focus on the New York art scene, the skills you learn here are applicable to galleries anywhere.

Gallery Walk: Most New York galleries hold their openings on Thursday nights and we will explore the galleries in the East Village and Lower East Side. This is a chance to view the works of famous artists, meet gallerists, socialize with like-minded art goers and be an integral part of the inspiring art scene of New York City.

Open Studio: Friday is designated as an open studio day to complete your paintings. The instructor will be present to give full support and instruction to the resident artists to complete all artwork for exhibition.

Art Exhibition: On the Saturday night of the residency from 6-9pm Dacia Gallery will host a formal Opening Reception & Exhibition presenting your work in a group show that is open to the public.

RESIDENCY INSTRUCTORS

Billy Seccombe: His work combines academic realism with a hint of playful theatrics utilizing costuming, patterns, impasto textures, and vibrant colors. His paintings examine empowerment, fashion, and seek to capture small moments. Seccombe's work as a painter has been hung in various galleries across the United States and has been recognized with awards and honors. He is a member of the renowned Portrait Society of America and is an instructor of painting and drawing at DuCret School of Art in Plainfield, NJ. Lee Vasu: Vasu is an Artist, Iconographer, Curator and the Founder of Dacia Gallery in New York City. ACCOMPANYING INFO

Arrival in NYC for May 2025 Session: Artists need to arrive in New York City by: (Friday, May 30 2025) Students meet each other on the respective Friday evening at 5pm at Dacia Gallery where a formal introduction and a festive welcome reception will be held.

Housing: Artists are responsible for their own housing accommodation during the time of the residency program in NYC. Previous artists have used airbnb.com to find affordable accommodations. Typically, airbnb.com is the best resource for temporary accommodations in NYC.

Airport: There are three major airports where artists can fly into New York: John F. Kennedy International Airport (JFK); LaGuardia Airport (LGA) and Newark Liberty International Airport (EWR). Artists are responsible for the cost and booking of their flights to and from New York.

Art Materials: Artists must bring their own art supplies. Once you have registered for the artist residency, we will provide you with a materials list and art supplies stores in Manhattan.

We have planned the New York & London international exchange project 'Art Discovery Project 2025' in collaboration with DACIA Gallery and ESPACIO Gallery in New York, containing our hopes for this. The composition of this project is that artists affiliated with spaceD9 will participate in the exhibitions at Project 1. DACIA Gallery, New York, USA, [Mirrored Questions in New York] and Project 2. ESPACIO Gallery, London, UK, [Primal Curiosity].

Exhibition requirements

- Works: Original works of the artist that do not violate copyright laws, no restrictions on the subject
- Fields: Paintings, drawings, prints, photographs, illustrations, handmade, two-dimensional & three-dimensional installations
- Work size

Two-dimensional works: Works less than $68 \times 48 \text{cm}$ (including size if framed) Three-dimensional works: Works less than $25 \times 25 \times 25 \text{cm}$ (each side less than 25 cm in width \times length \times height)

- Number of works to be exhibited: 1 work
- * If the three-dimensional props to be exhibited are a set, less than 5 pieces will be recognized as 1 work. However, the exhibition installation area must be less than 25cm in each of the three sides of width × length × height.

Project 1. DACIA Gallery, New York, USA, [Mirrored Questions in New York] - 1 work submitted (The gallery will select and exhibit the submitted works)

Project 2. ESPACIO Gallery, London, UK, [Primal Curiosity] - 1 work submitted (The gallery will select and exhibit the submitted works)

- 2. Submit the application form and artist profile (free format) along with 3~5 high-quality digital images of the artworks that can be submitted.

Please compress the image file (jpg) with the artist's name and submit it by email.

- * The gallery will select and exhibit 1 final artwork from the list of submitted artworks.
- * Please save the jpg image file name as the artwork title and submit it.
- * Please make sure that the application form arrives by the deadline.
